<p><b>What does "GAMEBOX" stand for?</b> <i>God and Me Exploring Box</i></p>	<p><b>What are the names of Jesus' mother and father?</b> <i>Mary and Joseph</i></p>	<p><b>When Jesus was missing, where did the disciples find him and what was Jesus doing?</b> <i>Jesus was in a "lonely" place (where he could be alone) and he was praying.</i></p>	<p><b>Tell 2 ways that we are like sheep.</b> <i>We sometimes get lost, we need someone to take care of us, we're weak, we are loved by our shepherd</i></p>
<p><b>How many days did it take for God to create the world?</b> <i>Six days (God rested on the seventh day)</i></p>	<p><b>When do we celebrate Jesus' birthday?</b> <i>At Christmas (December 25<sup>th</sup>)</i></p>	<p><b>When the disciples asked Jesus to teach them how to pray, what did Jesus teach them?</b> <i>The Lord's Prayer.</i></p>	<p><b>True/False: The shepherd didn't care when only one sheep was lost.</b> <i>False: The shepherd cared so much about the one lost sheep that he left the others to go look for it.</i></p>
<p><b>What did God do on the 7<sup>th</sup> day?</b> <i>God rested.</i></p>	<p><b>Give two names for Jesus.</b> <i>Christ, Emmanuel, Savior</i></p>	<p><b>Give at least 2 reasons why people pray.</b> <i>To talk to God, to listen to God, to find strength, to ask for help for other people, to thank God, etc.</i></p>	<p><b>Name 3 people who act as "good shepherds" for you.</b> <i>Examples: parents, teachers, Sunday school teachers, uncles, aunts, grandparents</i></p>
<p><b>In whose image are we created?</b> <i>We are created in God's image.</i></p>	<p><b>True/False: Mary and Joseph thought up a name for Jesus all by themselves.</b> <i>False. The Lord sent an angel to tell them what to name Jesus.</i></p>	<p><b>True/False: Since Samuel was just a child, God talked to Eli the priest instead.</b> <i>False: God talked to Samuel.</i></p>	<p><b>True/False: Jesus wants us to be friends with people who have few friends.</b> <i>True: Jesus wants us to share God's love with all people.</i></p>

<p><b>What is the Sabbath?</b> <i>The Sabbath is a day of rest to honor God.</i></p>	<p><b>What actions show other people that you believe in God?</b> <i>Examples: praying, going to church, being kind to others</i></p>	<p><b>What are the two different kinds of HELP prayers that we should pray?</b> <i>Help others; help me</i></p>	<p><b>Give 2 words that describe Zacchaeus BEFORE he met Jesus.</b> <i>Alone, cheater, unhappy, lost</i></p>
<p><b>On what day were humans created?</b> <i>Day 6</i></p>	<p><b>What does "Emmanuel" mean?</b> <i>"God with us"</i></p>	<p><b>What does PATH stand for?</b> <i>Praise – Apology – Thanks – Help</i></p>	<p><b>Describe the change in Zacchaeus AFTER he met Jesus.</b> <i>He gave half his money to the poor, he repaid four times the money that he cheated from other people</i></p>
