Read to Picture, Ponder, and Put it into Action

Chart of Stories, Texts, Lessons

Patches are independent study units. “The Good Book” patch is considered the anchor patch and the first patch that should be earned. After that, the patches may be earned in any order. Each patch focuses on a single object and includes 3 stories that feature that object. Each patch will require 3 separate sessions (one session for each Bible story). Each Bible story will utilize the RP3 outline: participants will **Read** the passage, answer questions to **Picture** the story, discuss issues to **Ponder** its meaning, and choose an activity to **Put** into action.

Use the following chart to help you in the selection process. With your family or group in mind, choose the patch that may best meet their needs. Find the patch with stories that may resonate with your group at this point in their spiritual journeys.
