


## BIBLE BASICS RP3

### Read to Picture, Ponder, and Put it into Action



Use the *Bible Basics RP3 Patch Series* to GET INTO THE WORD! Time spent in the Bible is precious time with God. Complete the RP3 patches together as a family, or with your scout group or Sunday school class.

*[My Word] will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.*

The focus of the RP3 Series is on Bible STORIES and Bible STUDY.

**STORIES:** Each patch focuses on a single object and includes 3 stories that feature that object. Each patch will require 3 separate sessions (one session for each Bible story).

**STUDY:** Each Bible story will utilize the RP3 outline: participants will **Read** the passage, answer questions to **Picture** the story, discuss issues to **Ponder** its meaning, and choose an activity to **Put** into action. Participants will use the RP3 model as a basic outline for Bible study.

**ALL AGES:** Bible Basics RP3 is a series for people of all ages (school age and up). The curriculum for each patch includes questions for younger children, older youth, and adults, and is designed to be done in a family or group setting with all participants (including parents and leaders) earning the patch.

**PATCHES:** Each patch is designed to be a visual reminder of the Bible stories associated with that study unit. Patches should be used as a prompt to review past lessons.
