10 - What does "crust" represent? <i>[the foundation, God's love for us]</i>	10 - What does "sauce" represent? <i>[our spiritual heritage, our family heritage]</i>	10 - What do the "toppings" represent? <i>[our talents and gifts]</i>	10 - What does the "cheese" represent? <i>[the Ten Commandments; rules that help us]</i>	10 - What does the "bake" represent? <i>[the heat of tough times, the tools we need to survive]</i>	10 – What was in the young boy's lunch? <i>[2 fish and 5 loaves]</i>
20 - What's a mezuzah? <i>[a container on a doorway with the passage from Deut]</i>	20 - What is the name of Ruth's mother-in-law? <i>[Naomi]</i>	20 - How were Moses and Aaron related? <i>[they were brothers]</i>	20 - How old was Jesus when he was lost in the temple? <i>[12 years old]</i>	20 - What was the name of the king who threw the men in the fiery furnace? <i>[Nebuchadnezzar]</i>	20 - How many people were fed? How much food was left over? <i>[5,000 men plus women & children; 12 baskets]</i>
30 - What is Deut. 6:5? <i>[Love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might.]</i>	30 - What country is Ruth from? <i>[Moab]</i>	30 – How did the Israelites defeat the Amalekites? <i>[They held up Moses' arms]</i>	30 - When Jesus was lost, where did his parents find him and what did Jesus say? <i>[Jesus was in the temple talking with the teachers; Why were you searching for me? Didn't you know I had to be in my Father's house?]</i>	30 - What were the names of the 3 men thrown in the furnace, and why were they thrown in it? <i>[Shadrach, Meshach, & Abednego – they refused to worship the statue]</i>	30 - What is a "disciple" what is an "apostle" <i>[Disciple = student, someone who follows a leader Apostle = a person who is sent out to represent someone else]</i>
40 - What happened when the women went to the tomb? <i>[There was an earthquake, an angel moved the stone, when the women left to tell the disciples they met Jesus]</i>	40 - How old was Jesus when he was named? <i>[8 days old]</i>	40 – What was Timothy's gift? <i>[It was the gift of faith]</i>	40 - When the prodigal son returned home, what did he say to his father? <i>[I have sinned against heaven and against you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son.]</i>	40 - What was the name of Paul's companion, and why were they thrown in jail? <i>[Silas –when they healed the girl who predicted the future, her owners pressed charges against them]</i>	40 - Matthew tells the story of Jesus' final appearance with his disciples. What is the story called? <i>[the Great Commission]</i>
50 - What is John 3:16? <i>[For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.]</i>	50 - When Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the temple, what did they bring for a sacrifice? <i>[A pair of turtledoves]</i>	50 - What are the names of Timothy's mother and grandmother? <i>[Eunice & Lois]</i>	50 – When the prodigal son returned home, describe the reaction of both the father and the older son. <i>[The father ran to hug & kiss him, he was compassionate and forgiving, the older son was angry & jealous]</i>	50 - Why was the jailer going to kill himself? What happened instead? <i>[the earthquake opened the cell doors & loosened the chains & he thought everybody escaped; he & his household were baptized]</i>	50 – How can you obey the Great Commission? <i>[invite someone to church; share what you have learned in God and Family; pray for people who do not know Jesus, etc.]</i>
60 - How can the "crust" help you when times are tough? <i>[The crust is your foundation. Your foundation is God and God's love for you. When times are tough, you need to remember that Jesus died for you!]</i>	60 - How can the "sauce" help you when times are tough? <i>[Knowing your heritage & that you are connected to other people can help in tough times & when you feel alone]</i>	60 - How can "toppings" help you when times are tough? <i>[You can be helped by the gifts & talents that God has given you and others]</i>	60 - Recite the 10 commandments	60 - Name some "faith tools" that can help you through difficult times in life. <i>[prayer, the Bible, trust in God, Christian friends, knowing right from wrong, sharing our gifts, etc.]</i>	60 - What 3 things did Jesus tell his disciples to do? <i>[go & make disciples of all nations; baptize them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit; teach them to obey everything that I have commanded you]</i>
