

The P.R.A.Y. Program Activities that Overlap with AHG Badges

The P.R.A.Y. Series (God and Me, God and Family, God and Church, God and Life) is appropriate for American Heritage Girls who are members of Protestant and Independent Christian churches. The curriculum is Bible-based and includes many hands-on learning opportunities. Some of these activities overlap with AHG badges. The following list includes the badge requirements that overlap to some degree with the P.R.A.Y. Program. This list will only make sense if you have read the P.R.A.Y. Curriculum and are familiar with the program requirements. You may find it helpful to view the webinar on “AHG and the P.R.A.Y. Program.” This webinar is an overview of the PRAY curriculum and considerations for integrating it into your Troop's program.

GOD AND ME

The *God and Me* curriculum is designed to help children become best friends with Jesus and tell their story of “God and Me” together. Children will make a game in each lesson and keep their games in a GAMEBox (**God And Me Exploring BOX**). These games will reinforce the Bible lessons and provide opportunities for families to explore God's love together.

GOD AND FAMILY

The God and Family curriculum is designed to help youth understand the importance of family and God's role in a healthy family. Children will compare families and “pizza.” They will make a pizza as they study how families can grow together in God's love.

GOD AND CHURCH

The *God and Church* program will lead young people on a journey. It will be a faith journey with three parts: meeting Jesus, worshiping God, and witnessing and ministering for Christ. Participants will create either a video or a photo album to share what they have learned on their faith journeys. Young people will have the opportunity to work with their pastor or other Christian adult as they study the church's structures and objectives and participate in service projects that will give them a better understanding of the mission of the church.
